## **Calculating your Community of Worshippers**



Your Community of Worshippers (CoW) is the core membership of your parish aged 18 years or over. This will likely include the majority of people on your electoral roll as well as others who regularly attend church worship and activities both on Sunday and/or during the week.

#### This **includes** those who:

- come to midweek services
- are ill and unable to come to church.
- are away on holiday or business
- have home communions
- live in care or residential homes and would consider themselves to be full members of your church
- give regularly to the church and who attend services sometimes
- clergy and ordained members of the parish

### We do not include as members those who

- are visitors: holiday makers, baptism parties etc.
- consider their 'home' church to be another church.
- those who only attend a Fresh Expression such as 'Messy Church'
- receive ministry but have no other connection with your parish such as residents of care or residential homes who receive Holy Communion because the home is in the parish.

We will use a 5 year rolling average of worshipping community figures when calculating the Common Mission Fund request.

The form on the following page has been developed to assist parishes in calculating their WC in a consistent manner.
